

STAAR Result Look Up

Step 1

Go to <https://www.texasassessment.gov/> and enter your student's **6-Character Unique code** and **Date of Birth** to view their results. The same *Unique Access Code* will follow them as they progress through each grade until graduation in the 12th grade.

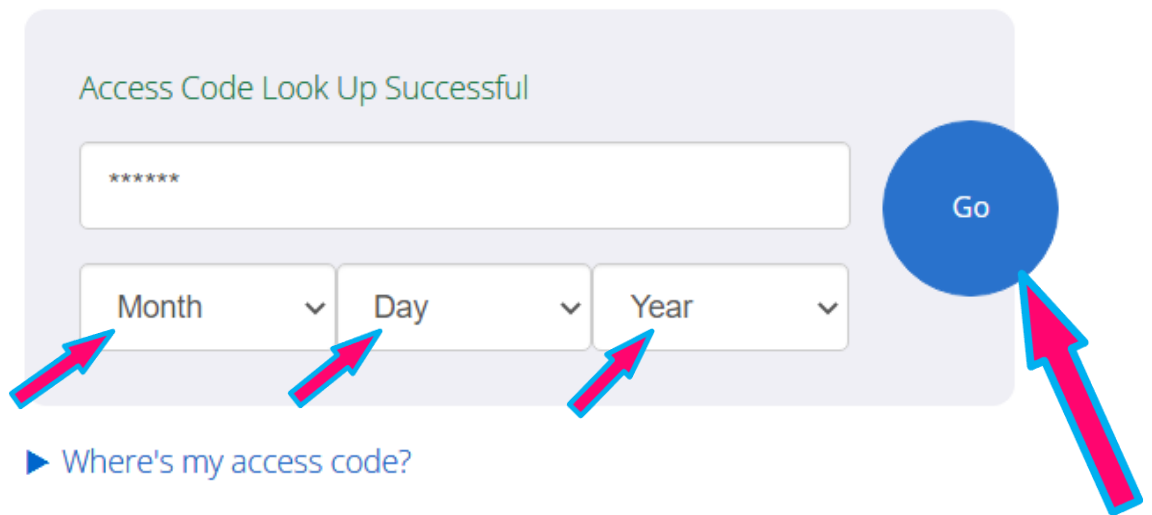
