Description:

The FY 18 Title IIA allocation has been increased by \$882. As part of a comprehensive district initiative that focuses on the preparation, training, recruitment, and retention of highly qualified educators, this grant provides \$68,746 in teacher stipends for the mentoring program for new teachers and the remaining budget of \$127,077 and was used for Professional Development contracts, conferences, and materials. Private school staff are served in proportion to their school's enrollment.

*Note: Under section 421(b) of the General Education Provision Act (also known as the *Tydings Amendment*), grantees can carryover funding for most federal Department of Education grants past the fiscal year in which grants are awarded.
