



Carroll County Republican Women 2021 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The Carroll County Republican Women Scholarship has been established to assist a high school graduate pursue his/her education. The recipient must show a high degree of motivation in pursuit of their education and have an active history of community service and/or political involvement with the Republican Party. CCRW will award one scholarship in the amount of \$500. Selection of the recipient will rest with the Carroll County Republican Women Scholarship Committee.

Eligibility:

- Applicant must be a U. S. citizen resident of Carroll County and a registered voter of Carroll County if 18 or older.
- Applicant must be currently a graduating Carroll County High School Senior, planning to attend a 2 or 4-year college or trade school in the Fall of 2020, with a GPA of at least 3.0

Scholarship Criteria: Each applicant must submit the following items to be fully considered for scholarship:

- Copy of Letter of Acceptance for enrollment from an accredited college or trade school, signed by an enrollment administrator
- Certified transcript listing GPA
- Attach two (2) letters of recommendations
- Scholarship Application must be signed by the applicant's high school counselor or college advisor
- Complete Page 2 of the Scholarship Application along with a 500-word essay on the topic listed.

Applicants will be judged on the submitted responses along with:

- Leadership Activities and Community Service
- Scholastic Achievement and Future Goals

Award Guidelines:

The Carroll County Republican Women Scholarship Committee will make the final selection based on above criteria as well as thoroughness of the written essay, with emphasis on good grammar and clarity. One scholarship of \$500.00 will be awarded to a graduating high school senior in May.

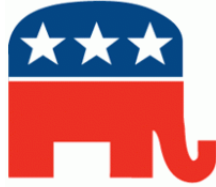
Deadline: All completed applications must be received by March 1st
