## Chromebook Coverage and Hotspots

Students assigned a district device (i.e., Chromebooks and hotspots) are responsible for all damages, whether intentional or accidental. Responsibility for a repair caused by a malfunction or maintenance issue will be determined by the Arlington Public Schools Technology Department.

### **Enrollment Information for Chromebook Protection**

The Chromebook Protection Plan Coverage Program is optional and provides an inexpensive solution for parents to reduce the financial burden if an accident or theft occurs.

Parents/guardians may decline to participate in the program, however, they will be liable for any damage or theft of the device. The Chromebook Protection Program will provide coverage for one calendar year (September to September) and is non-refundable. Students receiving a Chromebook after February 1st of each calendar year will be eligible for prorated coverage.

You may apply for Chromebook coverage by filling out the form in Skyward Family Access and paying the \$20 fee. This form will be available on September 1, 2020. Families who are eligible for free/reduced lunch may apply for a waiver.

#### ***Estimated cost for a repair:***

- Screen Replacement: \$100
- Water damage: \$160
- Keyboard replacement: 50
- Damaged/lost power supply: \$25
- Lost or stolen chromebook: \$200

The Chromebook Protection Plan Covers the following:

- Two repair incidents total, in any combination (damage), are covered per year.
- If the Chromebook is lost/stolen, the deductible amount is \$50.

If a student leaves the school district, but does not return the Chromebook, he/she will be fined for the full amount. Standard rules for the restriction of student records and transcripts would apply.
