TRANSPORTATION

There will be **NO** changes in your child's bus or van routes. Our van's are @ full capacity. If you need a change in your child's route they will need to be picked up.

Absence & Tardy Guidelines

8:05 AM students will be marked tardy and will need a tardy slip from the office. (If the bus or van arrives late the student will not be marked tardy.)

Arriving after 10 AM students will be marked present for a half day.

Students have to be in school until 1:30pm to be counted towards a full day. If a student leaves before 1:30 it is considered a half day.

BUS SAFETY

As of Friday January 7th, 2021 the bus has **cameras** to ensure the safety of our students and deter damages to the bus.

Please send your child with the proper winter gear.
A coat, stocking cap, gloves, snowpants & boots are required.
We want to keep our students safe & warm.



If You Test Positive for COVID-19 (Isolate)

Everyone, regardless of vaccination status.

- Stay home for 5 days.
- If you have no symptoms or your symptoms are resolving after 5 days, you can leave your house.
- Continue to wear a mask around others for 5 additional days.

If you have a fever, continue to stay home until your fever resolves.

If You Were Exposed to Someone with COVID-19 (Quarantine)

If you:

Have been boosted

OR

Completed the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine within the last 6 months

OR

Completed the primary series of J&J vaccine within the last 2 months

- Wear a mask around others for 10 days.
- Test on day 5, if possible.

If you develop symptoms, get a test and stay home.

If you:

Completed the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine over 6 months ago and are not boosted

OR

Completed the primary series of J&J over 2 months ago and are not boosted

OR

Are unvaccinated

- Stay home for 5 days. After that continue to wear a mask around others for 5 additional days.
- If you can't quarantine you must wear a mask for 10 days.
- Test on day 5 if possible.

If you develop symptoms get a test and stay home
